- 10.5 **Umpire Courses** - All new courses and dates will be put on the Surrey Website as well as CNL.
- 10.6 **London Youth Games 2024** - An U14 team entered this year and held at Redbridge Sports Centre. Despite the girls efforts they lost out by 2 goals to go through to top section from first rounds and finished top of the regrouping. Everyone enjoyed the experience.
