10.1 **Code of Conduct** - Clubs asked to watch out for a revised document for completion and return

10.3 **Regional League** - Roundwood remain in Division 2 for the coming season.

10.4 **Awards/Trophy Presentation** -The Chairman will present trophies/medals from 19/20 season at the first available opportunity, at the beginning of the new season.

10.4 **Umpires Courses** - JP explained the system in relation to attending courses online and practical assessments.

10.5 **Colours** - None issued this year.

10.6 **Qualified Umpire Awards** - None for previous season.

10.7 **Courses** - All new courses and dates will be put on the Surrey Website as well as CNL.

10.8 **London Borough Youth Netball Team 2020** - JM confirmed no competition took place in 2020.

10.9 **London Youth Games 2021** - JM explained the situation with Croydon Council/Borough on entering the Games this year due to financial constraints. However, Nike appreciated the predicament and a Croydon Team will be taking part.

10.10 **Umpiring Expenses** - Recommended change to qualified umpire game fees to £20.00 for the Winter League matches and the Evening League to remain £15.00. As in previous years, Trainees will be expected to refund £5.00 to the League and will retain £15.00 per Saturday game fee. Invoices will be issued twice per season.

10.11 **England ENgAge System** - Still causing problems which they hope to resolve.

10.12 **Julia Martin CNL Long Service Award** - Put on hold for a further year.
