- There are regular reports appearing in The Croydon Advertiser. Please send your match reports to Karen Gillick. We need more/different teams reporting!
- Chairmans Cup is underway. The first round is comprising of just 6 teams, the winners of this round will then join the other teams for the 2nd round.
- Unfortunately due to dwindling numbers the proposed CNL Charity Race Night on the 30th October HAD TO BE CANCELLED. Hopefully another one will be re-arranged in the New Year.
- Your support would be much appreciated, that for all games being played on Saturday 7th November 2009 everyone is asked to wear something pink in aid of Breakthrough Breast Cancer and donate £2.00 per person. We hope everyone will join in and give their support to this very worthwhile charity.
- It has been decided instead of playing a Mixed Rally on the 14th March, we will have a New Rules Rally. Only the first 16 teams to apply will be entered (one team per club only) and there will be a £50 entry fee. This will cover the provision of all umpires and any profit will be donated to charity. - There is a C Award umpire course on November 29th and a Beginners course on 6th December, please see website for more details.
- All teams are reminded that England Netball rules confirm that a game can start and be played with 5 players, therefore please can you look at this when you are looking to cancel/postpone matches
- Can everyone please ensure that everyone is aware in your club that the posts must be put away properly ie the post inserted into the base in the area adjacent to the pavilion.
- A umpiring rules forum, as mentioned at the AGM is still being planned and we should have a date for you in the very near future. Apologies for the delay.

- Some various points were brought to the Leagues attention regarding umpiring this season. The following points/questions were asked and we have answered them as follows.

Unqualified umpires should be distinguished so that clubs are aware prior to the match of the situation.

We agree and enclosed in this newsletter is a list of those qualified and those not.

Unqualified umpires should not receive the same honorarium as qualified umpires, there needs to be an incentive to go for the umpiring test. If an unqualified umpire has been on her course and not taken her test and passed within a year, how long is she accepted at CNL level. (Is this monitored?).

We are aware of all members that attend courses, apply for their test and if they pass or not. We have now decided to set up a support network within the committee to follow this up in more details and help trainee umpires get ready for their tests and apply (or reapply). The fee of £10 was set and agreed at the AGM. It can be discussed and voted upon again at this seasons AGM in July.

At the AGM it was agreed that unqualified umpires would be used as a last resort, however it appears that they are been used to support the umpire system and this has got to be a backward step. Also it was supposed to be one unqualified umpire per match but some matches have had two unqualified umpires down to umpire. Where is the development?

The umpiring list for the season has been re-done and re-done and we have ensured that there is always at least a qualified umpire on every match. All trainee umpires have been assessed and we have tried to make sure they are on matches we feel capable of. Unfortunately due to the lack of qualified umpires volunteering for matches, we had to resort to unqualified. It has now been decided that if qualified are unavailable for matches that require them, the games will have to be re-scheduled.

What happened to the rule that each team MUST supply a qualified umpire to the League, it appears to be missing. This is not a CNL rule. It was a requirement upon entry to the League. Every team did put forward an umpire per team, some have since withdrawn. Next season clubs without an umpire will not be allowed to enter and we will be adding this to our League membership rules. All teams this currently effects will be written to over the next few weeks so they know they have the rest of the season and the summer to find an umpire. Next season if the same clubs don't supply umpires once the League has started, consideration will be given as to whether they are accepted.

CNL must be seen to be in step with other leagues where qualified umpires are insisted upon and the honorarium is set to encourage the top umpires and appears to rise with the times. Many of the other leagues don't insist on qualified umpires and the fees are not set either. It is mainly up to club discretion.

If club "A" puts an unqualified umpire into the pool then they should receive an unqualified umpire out of the pool. We do agree, but what if club 'A' is playing club 'B' that hasn't supplied a qualified umpire? We will be looking at games where clubs without umpires are playing each other and then their game will not be a priority when allocating umpires for that particular match.

We are all trying to improve our game and we can only do this is we move forwards and not backwards. We absolutely agree, however in order to move forward we MUST support all our trainee umpires and help them get qualified. Comments on court from players do not help, so can all members please be aware of how they behave on court. We fully appreciate players concerns and welcome any suggestions/help/comments.
