12. *Points Clarification - Rule 10.4 - to save any confusion please note the following -*

ii) *score more than 50% of the winning teams score - example is 30-16 (not 30-15)*

13. *Umpires Attire - please could umpires make sure that when umpiring they are totally recognisable by all players and where possible in a neutral colour ie white.*
